

Dr. Clinton Williams – United States Department of Agriculture, Arizona

Dr. Williams has been actively engaged in water quality and quantity research for 20 years. Currently, he is a lead research soil scientist for USDA Agricultural Research Service in Maricopa, AZ, responsible for investigating the reuse of treated wastewater for irrigation, ground water recharge and environmental release. Previously, Dr Williams was a program director for the California State Department of Water Resources (2001-2002) where he was responsible for the San Joaquin Valley Drainage Implementation Program. Prior to that, he was a visiting Assistant Professor at Utah State University (1999-2001). He completed his PhD and Post-Doctoral research at the University of California, Riverside (1995-99).
