



Dr. Isam Sabbah (D.Sc.), the founder of Agrobics, is an expert researcher in water and wastewater treatment with a BSc in Chemical Engineering, and a D.Sc. in Environmental Engineering from the Technion, Israel Institute of Technology, Haifa. Dr. Sabbah is a senior lecturer in the Biotechnology Engineering Department at Ort Braude College in Karmiel and a senior researcher at the Galilee Society Institute of Applied Research. Prior to the current positions, he was the Scientific Director of the Galilee Society's Research and Development Center (2005-2007), a Design Engineer at Goldshmidt Environmental Engineering and Design in Tel-Aviv, and an Environmental Engineer at the Shefa-Amr Municipality. He was postdoctoral fellow at Johns Hopkins University (2001-2003) and the Imperial College (1997-1998). Dr. Sabbah received the Miriam and Aaron Gutwirth Award, for academic excellence sponsored by the Technion, the Lord Goodman Scholarship, sponsored by the British Council and the prestigious Maoff award sponsored by the Higher Education Council. His research interests are in the fundamentals and application of physico-chemical processes and development of immobilization technologies for advanced engineered biological systems. Dr. Sabbah has authored and co-authored numerous publications in professional peer-reviewed journals and presented papers at numerous international conferences.
