As part of her roles, Ziva was highly active in negotiations, and business and commercial related initiatives, including contracts signing and industrial co-operation procurement with private and defense industries and government agencies.

In the last 18 months, Ziva served as chief of Staff of the Communication & Home Front Defense offices lead by minister Gilad Ardan. At this position Ziva was responsible for the promotion and execution of big-scale reforms in the local communication market.
