

Dr. Tamar Berman is Chief Toxicologist for Environmental Health at the Israel Ministry of Health. Tamar is a regulatory toxicologist active in policy development related to a broad range of environmental health issues including evaluation of pesticides and biocides; chemicals in drinking water; and consumer products. Tamar has co - authored the reports *Environmental Health in Israel 2014*, *Environmental Health in Israel 2017*, *Environmental Health in Israel 2020*.



Tamar is responsible for developing recommendations regarding guideline values for chemicals in drinking water in the framework of the Drinking Water Advisory Council. Tamar leads the National Biomonitoring Program, which focuses on measuring environmental chemicals in biological samples in the general population, and using biomonitoring results to support environmental health policy.
