Roy Wiesner is CEO of Hutchison Kinrot, a global leader seed investor in water and clean technologies and the operator of a technology incubator located in central Israel. Kinrot is owned by Hutchison Water, a division of global conglomerate CK Hutchison Holdings Limited.

He was previously a partner at the Cross-Border M&A and Capital Markets Department at one of Israel's prestigious law firms, where he advised entrepreneurs, start-ups and public companies, across various sectors, on all aspects of capital raising and strategic transactions, and acted for private equity firms on their early and late stage investments.
