

**Tour 5: Water Utility Management**

**1. Mei Barak in Bnei Brak**

Mei Barak is a water and wastewater utility that provides service to the 200,000 residents of Bnei Brak. Mei Barak operates water and sewage facilities throughout the city, including water pools and water and sewage networks.

**2. Mei Avivim in Tel Aviv**

Mei Avivim is the water utility of Tel Aviv-Jaffa, operating under full ownership of Tel Aviv's municipality. Mei Avivim provides service to over 465,000 residents, carries out over 100,000 service calls per year and answers over 200,000 calls annually.

**3. Mei Netanya in Netanya**

Mei Netanya is the water utility of Netanya, which provides water and sewage services to the 200,000 residents of Netanya. Mei Netanya turns sewage water into reclaimed water for irrigation needs and natural fertilizers, ensuring all wastewater is reused.
